

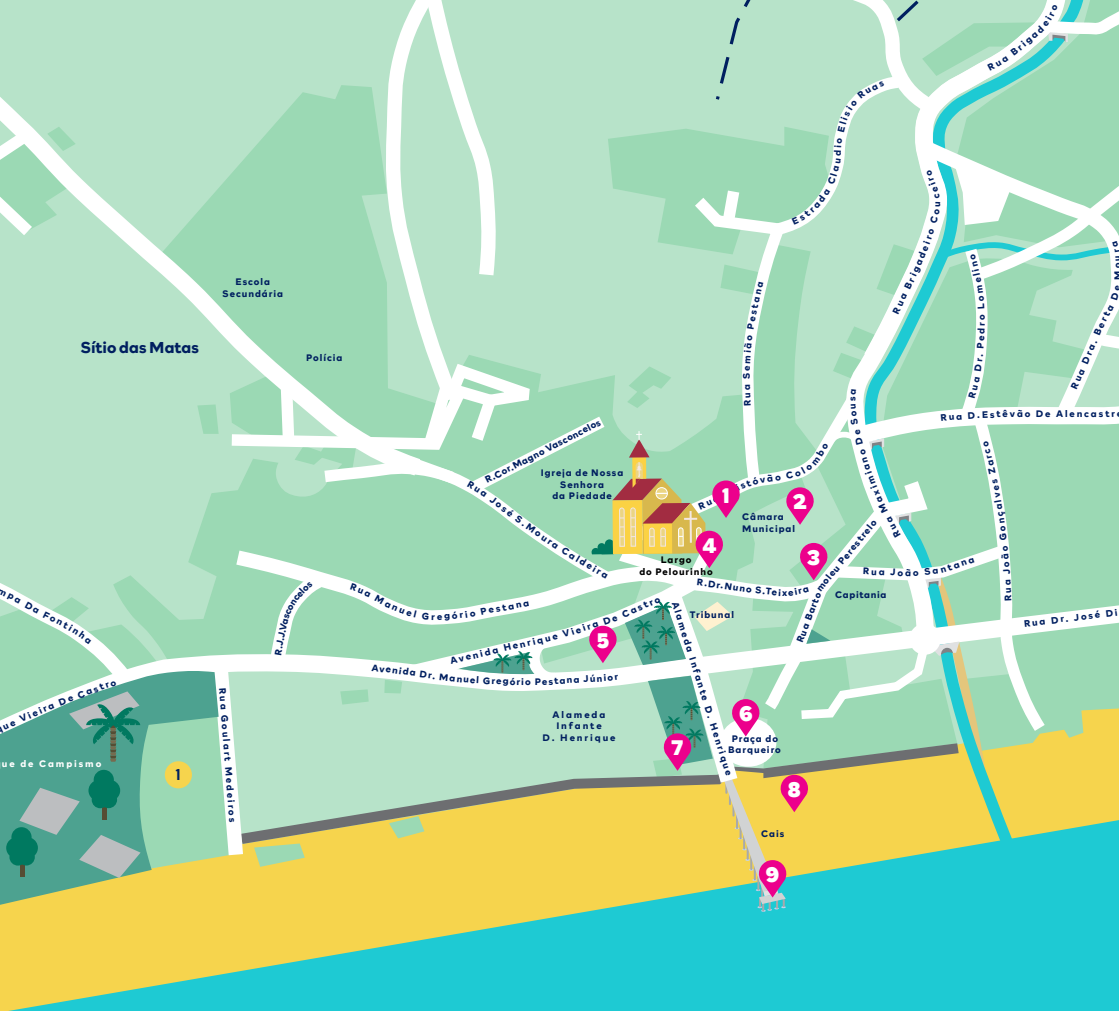

The Columbus Festival is based on a set of tourist entertainment initiatives which portray the time when this famous merchant lived on Porto Santo Island, recalling his experiences in the Madeira Archipelago and the epic of the Portuguese Discoveries. The event evokes the passage of the Genoese navigator on the Golden Island and includes a handicraft market, thematic exhibitions, streets, circus arts, theatrical performances, a lot of music and medieval dances, guaranteeing continuous animation and a constant bustle among the various personalities characteristic of the era.
